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

Along with it information regarding the modes of transmission and prevention of HIV/AIDS can also be conveyed to the participants.</p>

The participants are asked to put red counters on negative behavior practices and green on the positive ones. This tool can be used to help inform the people the ideal behavior that should be kept with HIV infected people so as to help them lead a happy life.</p>
	Color TV (Both Side) [PPTCT]	Sunboard	350.00	<p>Topic Covered PPTCT</p> <p>Description This tool consists of a picture portraying unsafe behavioral practices through which HIV/AIDS can be transmitted from a mother to child, which when pulled out portrays several pictures displaying the desired behavioral practices that can lower the risk of the child from being affected from the same. It can be used to explain the importance of ART to prevent the transmission of HIV/AIDS along with other methods to prevent it.</p>

It can be used to explain the importance of ART to prevent the transmission of HIV/AIDS along with other methods to prevent it.</p>
	Dori Game [Discrimination against HIV infected people]	Ply and Paper	400.00	<p>Topic Covered Discrimination against HIV infected people</p> <p>Description This tool consists of a board with pictures on it along with one red and one green thread. In this the participants are asked to tie green thread on the pictures depicting positive behavior towards HIV+ people and red thread on the pictures depicting discrimination practiced against them. Through this tool the facilitator can inform the people the ideal behavior that should be kept with HIV infected people so as to help them lead a happy life.</p>
	Flip Change [Importance of ICTC and Services provided in PPTCT centers]	MDF Art Card	250.00	<p>Topic Covered Importance of ICTC and Services provided in PPTCT centers</p> <p>Description This tool focus on giving information on the services provided under ICTC and at the PPCTC centers. Since one play a crucial role in detecting the HIV infection and the other in the prevention of transmission from the mother to the child, hence knowledge of both is important to gain.</p>
