	Building Block [Child's Fundamental Right]	Plastic Box	1000.00	<p><b>Topic Covered</b> Child's Fundamental Right</p> <p><b>Description</b> This tool consists of ten blocks depicting scenarios in which the child both is provided and is not provided with his/her essential rights, in the form of pictures. The participants are supposed to arrange these blocks in such a way that it forms a straight tower. Through this tool the facilitator can also spread a message on a child's right towards the decision making in his life.</p>
	Card Vanish [Female Feticide]	Plastic	350.00	<p><b>Topic Covered</b> Female Feticide</p> <p><b>Description</b> It aims to spread an understanding regarding son preference and its relation to sex-selective abortions and also to build strategies to put an end to sex-selective abortions leading to female feticide. In this the participants are asked to assemble the jigsaw puzzle. When completed, the puzzle would emerge as a faceless figure of a girl, symbolizing missing girls in India due to an increase in female feticide and infanticide.</p>
	Changing Scenario [Child Trafficking]	Plastic and Metal	350.00	<p><b>Topic Covered</b> Child Trafficking</p> <p><b>Description</b> This tool consists of two chips containing pictures portraying child trafficking which when rubbed against each other display pictures in which ideal scenario is depicted. It can be used to aware the masses about the types of child trafficking, the reasons behind it and the laws made by the government to stop it.</p>

Through this tool the facilitator can understand the participant's understanding on the topic of child labor and can help initiate a discussion on the same informing the participants the negative impact it has on a child and his/her growth and the ideal scenario which should be.</p>
